The Morgan Grand Nationals entry deadline will be published in the prizelist posted in May. Entering Grand Nationals (GN) prior to the closing date for horses/riders not qualified as of the closing date: Horses and/or riders that have not been qualified as of the closing date but intend to qualify before the opening day of the show must enter, pay fees and declare show for qualification by the closing date. Failure to qualify for any one class will result in entry refund for that class only. Failure to qualify for all classes entered will result in full refund of entry fee(s), stall fee(s) and drug fee(s) relative to that horse less the \$50 office fee. To obtain this refund, a letter must be obtained from the show secretary of the declared show stating that the horse was actually entered, shown and judged, including the placing of the horse and must be presented to the Grand National Show Secretary prior to the beginning of this show.

Directions to Nearest Emergency Care Facility (CHI Health St. Elizabeth at 555 S. 70th St, Lincoln, NE): Go south on N. 84th Street (or north on N. 84th Street and make a U-turn), turn right onto US-34 W or "O" Street, then turn left onto S. 70th Street (approx. 4.2 miles). (No EMT will be onsite as USEF Competition Lite rules waive the medical personnel rule if there is emergency service within 15 miles of the venue or cell service is available at the venue.)

Concessions will be provided by the facility and will be open Friday evening and during show hours.

ENTRIES AND SAFE SPORT NOTICE

Complete the entry form, including ALL required numbers and signatures, and mail with a check written to Central Region Morgan Show, c/o Megan Starnier, 18000 South 134th Street, Bennet, NE 68317. PayPal payments to centralregionshow@gmail.com are also accepted. To avoid late entry fees, entries with payment or signed open check must be postmarked by August 15 or received by August 20. You must provide a negative Coggins (if out-of-state) and vaccination records to the show office before receiving your number. Post entries will be accepted subject to the late entry fee and management approval. Returned checks are subject to a fee of \$50 and entry must be covered by a money order, cashier's check or cash including the penalty. Unpaid fees will be subject to USEF rules and regulations.

If you wish to compete for AMHA or USEF qualification or awards programs, include copies of these memberships and your horse's registration papers. Participants at USEF Competition Lite shows are not required to have a current USEF membership and, therefore, are not required to complete the Safe Sport training, but USEF members suspended due to not taking the Safe Sport training will not be allowed to show until a "SafeSport Trained" certificate is provided to show management. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Per Nebraska Department of Agriculture regulations, [out-of-state horses](#) must travel with official identification; a negative Equine infectious Anemia (Coggins) test within 365 days prior to entry; and a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued by an accredited veterinarian 30 days before entry (with official ID numbers, Coggins test result and test date recorded on the CVI).

The show committee asks that all horses be current on all vaccinations recommended by your veterinarian, and any horses with a temperature or signs of contagious conditions stay home, and everyone is asked to use common sense biosecurity measures before, during, and after the show. The facility disinfects stalls between shows and additional disinfectant is available through concessions.

Please note that USEF Competition Lite shows are required to follow USEF's GR845 Equine Vaccination Rule:

- 1. At Federation licensed competitions horses, more than 7 months of age, entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of **Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables**. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.*
- 2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.*
- 3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.*
- 4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.*
- 5. Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee.*

DIRECTIONS TO FACILITY (LANCASTER EVENT CENTER, LINCOLN, NEBRASKA)

From I-80 East or West: Take exit 409 for US Hwy 6 toward Waverly. Turn left onto Hwy 6 toward Lincoln for 2.7 miles. Turn left onto 84th St and continue for 1 mile. Turn left onto Havelock Ave or into the Event Center from 84th St. Phone Number: 402-441-6545

AWARDS

First place rosettes will be awarded and ribbons for 2nd through 6th places. In addition to ribbons (1st-6th), medal class winners will receive AMHA medals and equitation class winners will receive rider medals. Champions and reserve champion awards will be given in championship classes. Prize money will be mailed by check to the address provided on the entry form within 30 days.

FEES

AMHA Star Rated Shows allow non-AMHA members to show. USEF Competition Lite shows do not require USEF memberships, show passes, or drug fees. Please review membership requirements for all optional qualification and awards programs before showing.

Office Fee: \$25 per horse

Late Entry Fee (entry mailed or received post deadline): \$50 per horse

Parking Fee: FREE vehicle and trailer parking. Please observe signs for parking directions.

Horse Stall (10' x 10' canvas), includes facility stall cleaning fee of \$20 per weekend:

\$100/Fri-Sat-Sun (2 nights) + \$25/additional nights Tack Stall (provide your own lock): \$25/day Jump Out Fee: \$10/horse/day

Stalls are temporary and doors are provided. Note on your entry if you require a stallion stall (solid panels instead of bars) or double stall (\$5 fee).

*The limited number of stalls on dirt will be assigned first before assigning stalls on concrete floors. Enter early if you prefer dirt floors!
Note the date/time of your arrival on your entry if you wish to arrive earlier than 12 noon on the Friday before the show (\$25 per additional night).*

Shavings (delivered to your stall): \$9/bag Rubber Stall Mats (set up in your stall): \$15/stall/day

Note from the facility: Your shavings purchase helps the non-profit Lancaster Event Center defray the cost of delivering shavings, disinfecting each stall with Nixall between each show, and post-show bedding removal. Thanks for your support of our NO OUTSIDE SHAVINGS policy. Any bedding material other than LEC shavings will be fined \$50/stall. LEC staff will be reporting violations daily to show office as part of stall counts.

Camping (reservations at LancasterEventCenter.org or onsite): \$10/night without electrical or \$25/night with electrical
Wireless Internet: Available for a small daily fee by selecting "LEC-Guest".

Class Fee for Leadline: FREE (must submit completed entry to receive back number, no office fee if showing leadline only)

Class Fee for Walk-Trot/Fitting & Showmanship/In-Hand/Academy: \$10/class

Class Fee for All Other Classes: \$20/class (except Championships)

Championships: FREE if you place first or second in your qualifying class or \$40/class if you do not.

***** Add A Class (must order by entry deadline, will be added to the end of a session): \$50/class or \$75/championship *****

Late Entry Class Fee: FREE but advance entry is recommended by show management. Post entries can only be accepted prior to the starting of the class and upon signature of exhibitor or his agent and trainer.

Junior Exhibitors (age 17 & under) may show for a daily rate of \$50/day for unlimited class entries (excluding championships)!

REFUND POLICY

Office fee is not refundable. Entries with written cancellation on or before the closing date will receive a 100% refund less the office fee. No refunds can be issued after the closing date regardless of reason.

ARENAS AND STALLING

All show arenas and our indoor warm-up arena are Kiser-designed indoor arenas with footing composed of sand/clay. Show arena (Multi-Purpose Arena) is 110' x 215' and accessible without dismounting from the warm-up arena. Stalling and a 70' x 200' warm-up arena will be located in Pavilion 2 (P2) plus a large round outdoor warm-up and lunging area are also available to our show but all other arenas are closed to our show this weekend. RULES AND REGULATIONS

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the show management whose decision shall be final.

Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges.

Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees.

Show management reserves to itself the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the show without being liable for compensation.

In accordance with the 1989 Federal Waste Tracking Act, which restricts the disposal of medical waste, bio-hazardous medical waste containers will be provided in the stable area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of this waste.

No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitor and those having official or requested duties to perform.

It is the tradition of the show that riders be correctly attired for the class in question, that attendants be neatly dressed and the horses properly presented. Management may in its discretion bar any person from entering the ring if not suitable presented to appear before an audience.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

CLASSES BY DIVISION

ADD A CLASS Contact the show manager by the entry deadline to request a class addition, subject to approval by show committee. **NO QUALIFICATION is necessary to participate in this show;** the italicized notes in parentheses after each section title are taken from the Morgan Grand Nationals prizelist and refer only to qualification requirements for Morgan Grand Nationals.

CHAMPIONSHIPS To be qualified to show in the championship classes, you must have been properly entered, shown, and judged in one qualifying class in the same division. There is no penalty to enter after your qualifying class. Prize money will be distributed 2/3 to Champion and 1/3 to Reserve Champion. **All championship classes are FREE if you place first or second in your qualifying class or \$40/class if you do not.**

CARRIAGE DRIVING SECTION *(To qualify for Morgan Grand Nationals: No qualification is required for the Carriage section.)* **These classes are \$20 per class or junior exhibitors (age 17 & under) may show for a daily rate of \$50/day for unlimited class entries (excluding championships).**
