Directions to Nearest Emergency Care Facility (CHI Health St. Elizabeth at 555 S. 70th St, Lincoln, NE): Go south on N. 84th Street (or north on N. 84th Street and make a U-turn), turn right onto US-34 W or "O" Street, then turn left onto S. 70th Street (approx. 4.2 miles). No EMT will be onsite.

Concessions will be provided by the facility and will be open Friday in the barn for arrivals and during show hours.

ENTRIES AND SAFE SPORT NOTICE

Complete the entry form, including ALL required numbers and signatures, and mail with a check written to **Central Region Morgan Show, c/o Lindsey Pinkham-Heiden, 20266 S. 190th Street, Adams, NE 68301**. PayPal payments to centralregionshow@gmail.com are also accepted. To avoid late entry fees, entries with payment or signed open check must be received by August 18. You must provide a negative Coggins (if out-of-state) and vaccination records to the show office before receiving your number. Post entries will be accepted subject to the late entry fee and management approval. Returned checks are subject to a fee of \$50 and entry must be covered by a money order, cashier's check or cash including the penalty.

AMHA Star Rated Shows allow non-AMHA members to show. Please review membership requirements for all optional qualification and awards programs before showing. If you wish to compete for AMHA qualification or awards programs, include copies of these memberships and your horse's registration papers. Participants are not required to have a current USEF membership and, therefore, are not required to complete the Safe Sport training, but per AMHA Star Show Guidelines, show management must consult and enforce the USEF suspended/banned list at the showgrounds <https://www.usef.org/safe-sport/sanction-list>.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Per Nebraska Department of Agriculture regulations, out-of-state horses must travel with official identification; a negative Equine infectious Anemia (Coggins) test within 365 days prior to entry; and a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued by an accredited veterinarian 30 days before entry (with official ID numbers, Coggins test result and test date recorded on the CVI).

The show committee asks that all horses be current on all vaccinations recommended by your veterinarian and any horses with a temperature or signs of contagious conditions stay home. Please use common sense biosecurity measures before, during, and after the show. The facility disinfects stalls between shows and additional disinfectant is available through concessions.

DIRECTIONS TO FACILITY (LANCASTER EVENT CENTER, LINCOLN, NEBRASKA)

From I-80 East or West: Take exit 409 for US Hwy 6 toward Waverly. Turn left onto Hwy 6 toward Lincoln for 2.7 miles. Turn left onto 84th St and continue for 1 mile. Turn left onto Havelock Ave or into the Event Center from 84th St. Phone Number: 402-441-6545

AWARDS

First place rosettes will be awarded and ribbons for 2nd through 6th places. In addition to ribbons (1st-6th), medal class winners will receive AMHA medals and equitation class winners will receive rider medals. A prize table organized by members of the Arabian Horse Association of Nebraska will offer fun prizes throughout the show. Champions and reserve champion awards will be given in championship classes. Prize money will be mailed by check to the address provided on the entry form within 30 days.

REFUND POLICY

Office fee is not refundable. Entries with written cancellation on or before the closing date will receive a 100% refund less the office fee. No refunds can be issued after the closing date regardless of reason.

ARENAS AND STALLING

All show arenas and our indoor warm-up arena are Kiser-designed indoor arenas with footing composed of sand/clay. Show arena (Multi-Purpose Arena) is 110' x 215' and accessible without dismounting from the warm-up arena. Stalling and a 70' x 200' warm-up arena will be located in Pavilion 2 (P2) plus a large round outdoor warm-up and lunging area are also available to our show but all other arenas are closed to our show this weekend. GENERAL RULES

All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the show management whose decision shall be final.

Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges.

Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees.

Show management reserves to itself the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the show without being liable for compensation.

In accordance with the 1989 Federal Waste Tracking Act, which restricts the disposal of medical waste, bio-hazardous medical waste containers will be provided in the stable area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of this waste.

No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitor and those having official or requested duties to perform.

It is the tradition of the show that riders be correctly attired for the class in question, that attendants be neatly dressed and the horses properly presented. Management may in its discretion bar any person from entering the ring if not suitable presented to appear before an audience.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

ADD A CLASS

Contact the show manager by the entry deadline to request a class addition, subject to approval by show committee.

NO QUALIFICATION is necessary to participate in this show. Refer to the latest Morgan Grand Nationals prizelist to confirm details before entering.

CHAMPIONSHIPS

To be qualified to show in the championship classes, you must have been properly entered, shown, and judged in one qualifying class in the same division. There is no penalty to enter after your qualifying class. Prize money will be distributed 2/3 to Champion and 1/3 to Reserve Champion. **All championship classes are FREE if you place first or second in your qualifying class.**

FEES

Office Fee: \$25 per horse

Late Entry Fee (entry mailed or received post deadline): \$10 per horse

Parking Fee: FREE vehicle and trailer parking. Please observe signs for parking directions.

Horse Stall (10' x 10' canvas), includes facility stall cleaning fee of \$20 per weekend: \$100/Fri-Sat-Sun (2 nights)

Tack Stall (can be shared with another exhibitor if you indicate on entry, provide your own lock): \$30/day

Jump Out Fee: \$20/horse/day

Stalls are temporary and doors are provided. Note on your entry if you require a stallion stall (solid panels instead of bars, no charge) or double stall (order 2 stalls). The limited number of stalls on dirt will be assigned first before assigning stalls on concrete floors. Enter early if you prefer dirt floors! Note the date/time of your arrival on your entry if you wish to arrive earlier than 12 noon on the Friday before the show (\$25 per additional night).

Shavings (delivered to your stall): \$12/bag Rubber Stall Mats (set up in your stall): \$20/stall/day

Note from the facility: Your shavings purchase helps the non-profit Lancaster Event Center defray the cost of delivering shavings, disinfecting each stall with Nixall between each show, and post-show bedding removal. Thanks for your support of our NO OUTSIDE SHAVINGS policy. Any bedding material other than LEC shavings will be fined \$50/stall. LEC staff will be reporting violations daily to show office as part of stall counts.

Camping (reservations at LancasterEventCenter.org or onsite): \$15/night without electrical or \$35/night with electrical
Wireless Internet: Available for a small daily fee by selecting "LEC-Guest".

Class Fee for Leadline: FREE (must submit completed entry to receive back number, no office fee)

Class Fee for Walk-Trot/Fitting & Showmanship/In-Hand: \$10/class

Class Fee for All Other Classes: \$15/class (except Championships)

Championships: FREE if you place first or second in your qualifying class or \$30/class if you do not.

***** Add A Class (order by entry deadline, will be added to the end of a session): \$50/class or \$75/championship *****

Late Entry Class Fee: FREE but advance entry is recommended by show management. Post entries can only be accepted prior to the starting of the class and upon signature of exhibitor or his agent and trainer.

Junior Exhibitors (age 17 & under) may show for a daily rate of \$65/day for unlimited class entries (excluding championships)!

CLASS SCHEDULE

Revisions to the show's class schedule will be posted on the show website prior to the show and final schedule will be posted at the competition office. There will be two sessions each day, one beginning at 9 a.m. and one beginning a minimum of one hour after completion of morning session. Arena drags will be during the lunch or session break. Show management encourages tack change requests to be made at the gate the class prior.

Medal patterns will be available online prior to the show and in the show office. Equitation classes will not include patterns except for the junior exhibitor championships.

If you identify conflicts in class schedules, please contact the secretary by e-mail or in the show office as soon as possible. Show management reserves the right to edit the class schedule and may combine classes to show concurrently (placed separately) and to divide classes for safety.

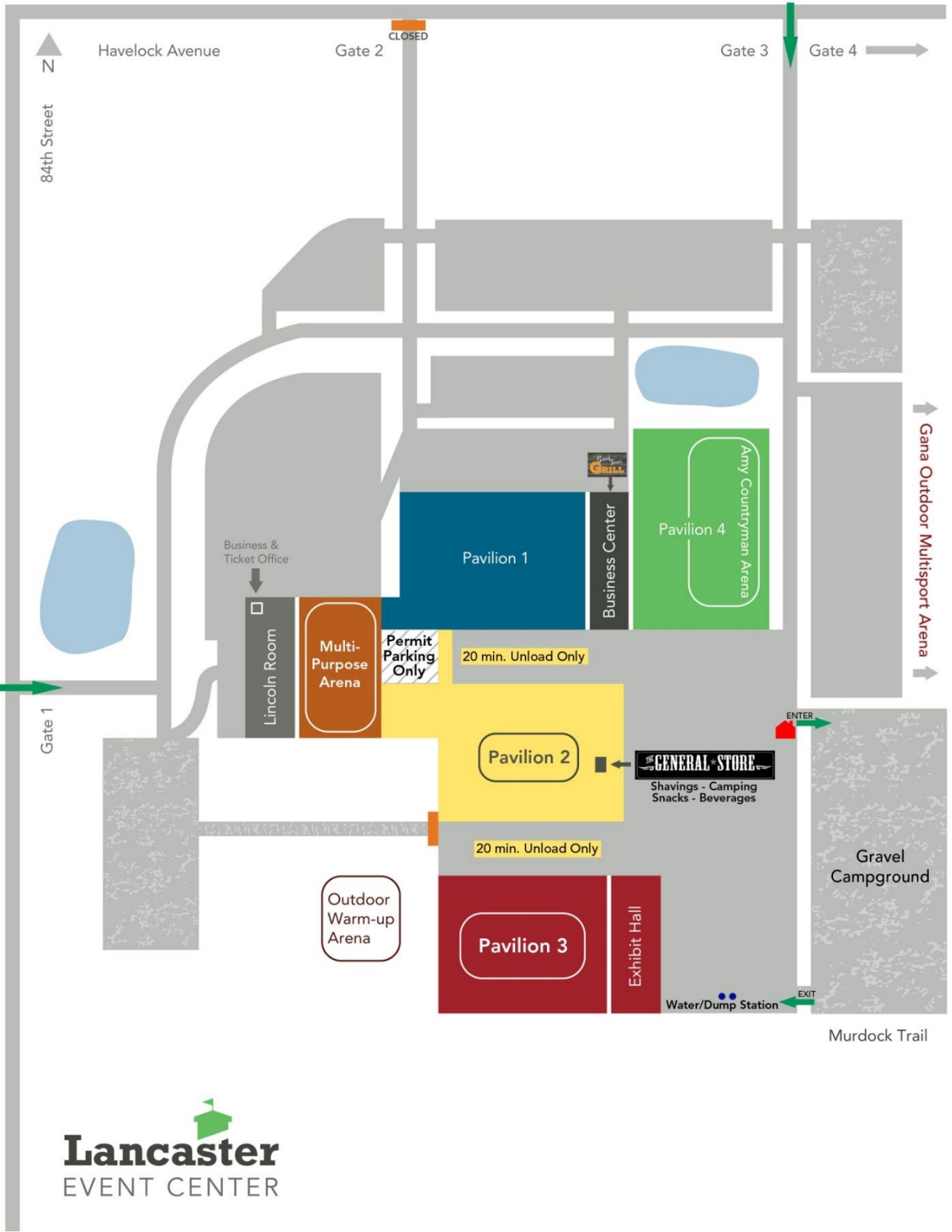
